Editorial


The city's awake!

It has been described as an 'orphan city', and a city without an identity. Hard to understand, growing geographically in all directions daily, Delhi has been a great challenge to the church. Christians barely constitute 1% of her population of 15 million.

Delhi is rapidly changing. Trends and fashions, peoples and places, shops and offices change almost every day. The past two years have seen 20 new flyovers and the new metro system among other major structural changes. Delhi is a city on the move, a sociologist's delight in all the emerging kaleidoscopic patterns of cultures and sub cultures, ethnic and occupational identities.

What is the role of the church in Delhi? We request our triends and prayer partners all over to pray for this city and for the Church here that we may be His witnesses, bringing light where there is darkness, hope where there is hopelessness and deliverance where there is bondage.
